THE FIRST STEP OF FAITH

FIRST IN FAITH, PART 1

“By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going.” (Hebrews 11:8)

Do not touch what is unclean, and I will receive you. I will be a Father to you, and you shall be My sons and daughters’, says the Lord Almighty.” (2 Corinthians 6:14-18)
