# THE BEAUTY OF THE DIVINE LITURGY

"And on the day called Sunday, all who live in cities or in the country gather together to one place, and the memoirs of the apostles or the writings of the prophets are read...then, when the reader has ceased, the overseer verbally instructs, and exhorts to the imitation of these good things. Then we all rise together and pray...when our prayer is ended, bread and wine and water are brought, and the overseer in like manner offers prayers and thanksgivings, according to his ability, and the people assent, saying Amen; and there is a distribution to each, and a participation of that over which thanks have been given..." Justin Martyr

#### You are not the primary audience!

Not one of the Fathers of the Church, though so numerous...not one of them ever said, It is only bread and wine; or, the body and blood of Christ is not there present...Certainly, in so many Fathers, and in so many writings, the negative might at least be found in one of them, had they thought the body and blood of Christ were not really present: but they are all of them unanimous." "We ask You, O our Master, receive our prayers to Yourself. Let our prayers be set forth before you as incense, the lifting up of our hands, as the evening sacrifice. For You are the true evening sacrifice, who has offered Yourself upon the cross for our sins..." Vespers (silent prayer)

"Christ our God, the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world, Lord hear us, have mercy on us and forgive us our sins." Offering

#### You can never out-give God.

"Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's."
