TRUE OR FALSE: "I'm not good enough." • My actions: TRUE • My identity: LIE

Philippians 3:4-9

"If anyone else thinks he may have confidence in the flesh, I more so: circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of the Hebrews; concerning the law, a Pharisee; concerning zeal, persecuting the church; concerning the righteousness which is in the law, blameless.

But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ. PHASE 1: CRISIS

PHASE 2: COMMITMENT

PHASE 3: CONFESSION

YOU CAN'T DEFEAT WHAT DON'T DEFINE. GOD WON'T HEAL WHAT YOU DON'T REVEAL.

PHASE 4: CHANGE

"Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but Israel; for you have struggled with God and with men, and have prevailed...And He blessed him there. So Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: "For I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved."" Genesis 32:28-30

GOD HAS A NEW NAME AND A NEW IDENTITY For you too.

"I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you to live in the grace of Christ and are turning to a different gospel which is really no gospel at all. Evidently some people are throwing you into confusion and are trying to pervert the gospel of Christ. But even if we or an angel from heaven should preach a gospel other than the one we preached to you, let them be under God's curse! As we have already said, so now I say again: If anybody is preaching to you a gospel other than what you accepted, let them be under God's curse! Am I now trying to win the approval of human beings, or of God? Or am I trying to please people? If I were still trying to please people, I would not be a servant of Christ." Galatians 1:6-10

HUMAN PRAISE IS TEMPORARY BUT GOD'S GLORY IS ETERNAL
